Also over 100 stamps in singles and pairs. Most items are mint hinged, fine-very fine plus a very few used.

The 11 are #1, 5, 11A, 18, 19, 19b, 20 and 20 VFNH block of four, and the 6 are #1, 13 (2 used, one cut into, the other lightly cancelled cut just at design, thinned), 15A, 22 and 23i, these somewhat cut into or with faults. The first group Scott CV \$832, the second \$2,290.

Condition is generally fine with many more highlights than the few we have listed.

**1527** Ⓞ **Late Queen Victoria-era Collection with Map stamps**, old time collection on album leaves, of the Queen Victoria 1897 Leaf issue to the 1899 Provisional issue. We note 6c, 10c Leaf, 6c-10c Numeral, mint block of four of the ½c Numeral. There are 21 1898 Map stamps, mostly used, detailing colour shades and printing varieties. Used stamps selected for cancels, generally fine or better.

**1528** Ⓞ **Early 20th Century**, 6 shirt boxes and one shoebox containing thousands of early 20th Century Canada, some on piece. We noted bundles of #105, 108, 112, 114, 115 (partial), 117, 141, 168-170, 202 and others deeper down in the one box. Weighs approximately 4kg but most off paper. Likely exceeds 50,000 stamps.

**1531** Ⓞ **Collection of fancy cancellations in two binders**, a better than average collection with over 1,400 mostly Small Queens (virtually all 3c value). We noted many coloured cancels, good quantity of better early shades and a wide variety of cancels with not much duplication. Many cancels are illustrated with D&S numbers. A very clean collection and rarely offered in this extensive a lot. Condition generally fresh and fine or better.

- 1539** ☉ **Collection of cds cancellations in three binders**, an above  
average quality collection of over 4,250 stamps from Small  
Queens (great majority) to 1950s. Large portion are socked  
on the nose, fully dated cancels. Noted small Prince Edward  
County collection, cancels from most provinces. A nice collec-  
tion.

blocks including over 80 mint never hinged plate blocks post-

of higher denomination stamps (\$1 Destroyer) plus \$1-\$5  
used modern stamps.

#291 and #299 signed by the Hon. George Drew, leader of  
His Majesty's Loyal Opposition (1950).

sists of over 275 stamps, mainly mint never hinged. Majority

- 1551** \*/\*\*/☉ **1859-1967 Collectors duplicates, primarily used**,  
in stockbook containing over 600 stamps or blocks of stamps  
including booklet panes. Also 28 Law Stamps from Ontario,  
Alberta, BC and Manitoba, plus back of the book issues, many  
of them mint never hinged. The Victorian era is well repre-  
sented with numerous interesting cancellations and shad-  
ings. Later issues usually selected for lovely postmarks.

**1552** \*/\*\*/⊙ **Collector stockbook of duplicates Victoria to KGVI**, mostly mint hinged or used, we note approximately 120 used Small Queens with a variety of shades and postmarks, 1908 Quebec used to 15c, 1912 1c yellow Admiral coil VFNH, 1929 2c carmine Admiral Provisional overprint VFNH, 1912 1c yellow Admiral imperf margin single with large margins and Newfoundland 1919 Caribou high values, fresh, lightly hinged, very fine. Overall fine-very fine.

**1553** \*/\*\*/⊙ **Collection of mostly tagging varieties in two stockbooks**, mostly from the 1960s with mint and used blocks and sheetlets, and many annotated by Bileski. Fine-very fine.

**1554** \*/\*\*/⊙ **1927-1979 Collection** on Scott pages. Mostly mint (hinged and never hinged) with some used. We note 1928 bluenose and \$1 Parliament both hinged, pair of 1933 20c pair with Broken X (NH), etc.

**1555** \*\*/⊙ **Collection remains**, consisting of singles, blocks (including plate blocks) having a face value of \$196 (mostly 12c to 43c plus some high values). Also includes 5 small boxes of single stamps on and off-paper, some worldwide.

**1556** \*/⊙ **Collection of approximately 4,000 3c Small Queens in 4 binders**, one contains over 500 dated with shades and ranging from 1870s to 1890s. We noted better shades with copper reds, deep rose carmines and several nicer town cancels. One binder has several hundred arranged by shade, paper and perf varieties. Noted one page filled with unused and several pages of better shades and papers. One binder contains over 1,000 printing varieties, all identified and illustrated for dots and plate scratches. Last binder contains a calendar collection from 1889 to 1898 with 2,000 different dates. Overall quality is very nice and these collections are getting hard to find intact.

**1557** \*/⊙ **1851-1964 Collection in large stockbook** Primarily used collection including some mint. Collection has duplication but usually has at least one in F-VF or better quality, otherwise mixed condition in early issues. We noted #1, 4, 5, 7, 1859 issue (19 - with #14 unused, 17 (2), 20), 1868 Large Queens (23 with #26, 27 unused, 28), Small Queens (68), 1897 Jubilees a complete set to the \$1 plus \$4 (these two have thins) and used \$2, \$3 and \$5. At least one complete set of 1897, 1898, 1903, 1908 (2 sets). The later mint hinged includes #116 (2 - one unused), 119, 132, 139 (3, 2 are NH), 158 (thin), 245, C2, E1, E3, E8. There is lots of extra value in duplication, mixed from average to very fine. Inspect. **See page 159 for photograph.**

**1558** \*\*/⊙ **1960s-1990s Collection in large stockbook**, with mixture of mostly mint never hinged and used stamps. Most stamps in sets, se-tenant pairs and some inscription blocks. Face value of mint stamps is \$345.

**1559** \*/⊙ **#4/877 1850s-1980 Mint and used collection**, on Minkus pages. We note 1859 10c brown purple Prince Albert; 1859 17c blue Jacques Cartier; 1868 12½c blue Large Queen; 20c Jubilee; Leaf and Numeral used sets complete; Edward set used; 7c Quebec mint hinged; 1911-1931 Admirals to the 1942 war Effort appears complete, mostly used; including most back of the book issues. Overall condition of the collection is fine.

**1560** \*/⊙ **#4/MR4 1852-1966 Mint and used collection**, with stamps hinged to black pages. Mainly mint hinged with some earlier material being used. We note #4 (repaired, maybe unused), #8 (likely unused, small mark), Jubilees to 50c, appears complete from 1897 Leaf issue through to the QEII period. Condition is mixed although overall with good colour and virtually all are fine or better. This collection should be inspected as it contains many nice stamps.

**1561** (\*) **#8/20 1857-1964 Group of 8**, unused no gum. We note the 1859 17c blue Cartier with deep colour, 1857 ½d rose with original gum and hinge remnant, 1859 5c beaver and 10c red lilac Consort with faults, 1859 1c rose re-perfed. Scott CV \$8,300

**1562** ⊙ **#14/1738 Red box containing dealers stock of used**, all identified and priced in 102 cards. Box is quite full and there is some duplication. Quality is overall average.

**1563** \*/\*\*/⊙ **#14/719 Collection in Schaubek hingeless album**, with some early issues mostly used, very sparse from 1897 to 1947. From 1947 to 1977 the collection is reasonably complete mint and mostly never hinged. Early issues are generally average, else fine-very fine.

**1564** ⊙ **#14/977 1859-1984 Used Collection**, on Minkus pages. We note 1897 Jubilees to 20c, 1908 Quebecs complete, 50c Bluenose, \$1 Parliament. Overall fine or better and many very fine, with in period postmarks. **See page 159 for photograph.**

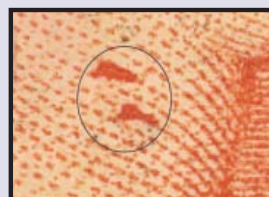
**1565** \*/⊙ **#15, 19, 19TCii 1859 selection of 5c beavers and 17c Cartiers**, includes three 5c Beavers, one with clear AP 4, 1866 double struck and one with 4-ring #24 from Oakville, C.W. postmark. The 17c Cartier has deep colour and clipped perfs. The 17c Carter orange proof is faulty. Unitrade CV \$380.  
 ..... **Est \$50**

- 1566**    Ⓞ **#15/20 1859-1864 Cents issue group** of 9 stamps including 5c (6 including stamps described as very thick and very thin papers, but not conclusively so), 10c, 17c and 2c rose, fine or better.

- 1567**    \*/Ⓞ **#17/400 1850s-1950s Old-time Canada collection on ledger pages**, mostly used with some mint hinged. We note: 2 shades of the 10c Prince Albert, Small Queens, 1897 Jubilees to 50c and many stamps in complete sets to the mid-1950s. A number of back of the book issues including 1915 Admirals overprinted "Inland Revenue War Tax" (unused no gum) and the 20c and 50c War Tax, Special Delivery, Registration, Officials and cut squares. Of interest are a number of Federal and Quebec revenue stamps. We note 1915 KGV \$1 Law Stamp, Canada Bill Stamps from the first three issues; 1856 \$1 red with green center Second Bill Issue (horizontal crease); tobacco stamps. As well mint stamps 1908-1939 tipped in a 6-page note book. Overall condition is fine.

- 1568**    Ⓞ **#21/30 1868-1875 ½c-15c Large Queens collection** Written up on 5 album pages with notes; about 20 stamps (no 1c values). Mixed condition but includes fine stamps with interesting cancels or light cancels so stamps appear unused and fine examples of the 2c and 12½c with watermark (#24a and 28a).

- 1569**    \*/\*\*/Ⓞ **#26/1361 Small accumulation of mint and used**, includes Large Queens, 10c Small Queen shades (5), mint Jubilee and Map blocks, Admirals, high denomination mint classics and various better items.

- 1570**    \*/Ⓞ **#29, 30 1868 15c Large Queen collection**, on 3 album pages and one stockpage of 39 stamps written up by collector. They are mostly #30 with about 5 of the blue-grays tending toward deep blue. Includes a good number of cds cancels. Inspect.

- 1572**    Ⓞ **#34-47 1870-1897 ½c-50c Small Queens** lifetime accumulation mostly on stockpages with notes by collector. Typically a dozen on more of most values but over 100 3c and the 10c with about 40, mostly later Ottawa printings. We noted many cds especially among the 10c. Condition is mixed with many average, Scott for the 10c through 50c is \$4,340. We didn't count the number of identified major re-entries but it will number in the dozens. There is a "vampire bite" variety but also quite a few equally prominent flaws not listed in Unitrade or other specialized literature. All pages with stamps are in protective pages in 5 thick binders. In addition there are a few hundred pages of scans showing additional information for a particular position.

There are quite a few earlier printings including dated copies, a few covers, a few mint or unused, and also more than 200 stamps identified with plate flaws but not identified by plate position. From the same consignor is a large quantity which were not included in this collection offered as a separate lot. This would be ideal for a collector or dealer to sell individually for a few dollars up to over a hundred per position because of the already prepared scan and "packaging" or to a collector who can make it a lifelong pastime to expand on this solid basis. 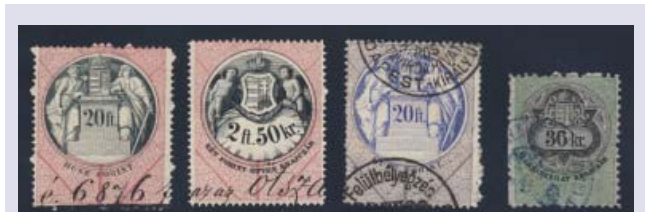

## TERMS & CONDITIONS (Please read carefully)

1. The property described in this catalogue will be offered at public auction by Sparks Auctions Inc. (Sparks) on behalf of various consignors. By bidding on any lot, whether in person, or through an agent, via Stamp Auction Network, by mail, email, fax, telephone, website, or any other means, the bidder acknowledges and agrees to all of the following Terms and Conditions of Sale.

2. The highest bidder acknowledged by the auctioneer shall be the buyer. The term "hammer price" means the last bid acknowledged by the auctioneer. The purchase price payable by the buyer will be the sum of the hammer price and a commission equal to 15% of the hammer price ("buyer's premium"), together with any sales tax which may be due on the sale.

3. All bids are per lot as numbered in the catalogue. The auctioneer shall regulate the bidding and reserves the right to reject any bid believed by him not to be made in good faith; to withdraw any lot prior to sale; to divide a lot; or to group two or more lots and to act on behalf of the vendor. In the event of any dispute, the auctioneer's decision shall be final. Sparks will execute bidding instructions on behalf of clients, but will not be responsible for any errors in the execution of such bids.

4. Unless a bidder has established credit with Sparks prior to the sale, Sparks must receive payment in full before the lots will be delivered. Buyers not known to Sparks must make payment in full within five days from the date of sale. Accounts more than thirty days in arrears will be subject to a late payment charge of 2% per month. All expenses incurred in securing payment from delinquent accounts will be charged to the defaulter. A fee of \$100.00 will be charged for any cheque returned for insufficient funds.

5. All sales are in CANADIAN FUNDS. Payment may be made by bank draft, bank transfer, cheque drawn on a Canadian or U.S. bank, Canadian or International postal money order, cash or credit card (VISA and MasterCard only). There are no additional fees for payment by credit cards if information is provided at time of bidding, otherwise an additional fee of 2.5% will be charged for credit card payments. Payment in U.S. funds is acceptable at the same rate which Sparks can purchase Canadian Funds at our bank (2.5% percent above the mid-market rate). Contact us if you require the exact amount owed in U.S. funds. Credit cards will be processed in Canadian Funds.

6. Buyers from Canada will be charged applicable Ontario Retail Sales Tax and Federal GST or HST. Absentee bidders resident outside Canada are not liable for Canadian taxes if purchases are delivered outside of Canada. See shipping instructions.

7. Until paid for in full, all lots remain the property of Sparks on behalf of the seller.

8. The buyer assumes all risk for delivery of purchased lots and agrees to pay for prescribed shipping costs.

9. Because the descriptions and scans of the auction will be available in a printed catalogue, our website and on Stamp Auction Network, there is a chance of technical error. In that event the auctioneer's decision will be final. If discovered before the sale a notice will be posted on sparks-auctions.com. Opening bids will be available on the websites and will be updated. These are only provided as a service to bidders and Sparks does not guarantee their completeness or accuracy.

10. Any lot, the description of which is obviously incorrect, is returnable, but only if the lot is returned within 14 days of receipt. All disputed lots must be returned intact with the original packing material. The following lots may not be returned for any reason: Lots containing ten or more items; any lot described with "faults" or "defects" may not be returned because of any fault or defect. No illustrated lots may be returned because of centering, margins or other factors shown in the illustrations.

11. All lots are sold as genuine. ## Notes on catalogue values and reference

Catalogue values are listed for most lots offered. These are the best available guides to the retail price of a single stamp or set provided that the item(s) are the same quality as the standard described in the introduction to each catalogue. Exceptional quality will often sell above the catalogue value; inferior quality will sell for less; faulty stamps in a lot can result in a sale price of a small percentage of the catalogue price.

When cataloguing collections we use the value for the grade specified. For Scott this grade is very fine. For Unitrade we use the grade specified at the start of the textual description. Thus a "fine" collection will have all stamps added at the fine price. We do not count obvious forgeries, reprints etc. and usually do not count faulty or ugly stamps. A lightly penciled X under a stamp means it was not counted in the catalogue value. We put a light pencil note beside more expensive stamps and put a total catalogue value at the bottom of each page to assist viewers.

The following catalogues have been used. If there is a variance, this will be mentioned in the text of the description. The term "owner's catalogue value" indicates a variety of approaches and may include older versions of catalogues. We will have inspected and reviewed the result but not re-catalogued; hence we do not vouch for the exact total of catalogue value.

Live bidding on the internet allows bidders anywhere in the world to participate in this auction. Sparks Auctions is pleased to make the auction available through Stamp Auction Network, and we will do everything we can for our customers to make the process simple, trustworthy and fun.

Register once and create a user name, which will allow you to choose auction firms to bid with, including Sparks Auctions. We need to confirm your account before you will be able to place bids with us. For faster bidder confirmation, please reference Ian Kimmerly, Sparks Auctions, or other North American auction houses when you create your account.

Once you have been registered and approved by us, you can:

**Keep track of lots you are interested in, and place bids on-line at any time before the auction begins.** This is similar to any other form of advance bidding (ie., sending us a bidsheet by mail, fax, etc.), but you will receive acknowledgement of your bids once they are submitted, and, if you wish, further confirmation by e-mail if you are outbid.

**Bid Live by watching action on-screen.** The Message window will tell you which lot is being offered, what the current bid is, and if it is approaching Last Call. Click the button

**Pass When You Are Done** If you have been actively bidding on an item and wish to drop out, **PLEASE PRESS THE PASS BUTTON.** If you do not, the whole auction is delayed.
